HEARD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING MAY 10, 2011 – 6:30 P.M.

The Heard County Board of Commissioners held a Commissioners Meeting on May 10, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. in the courtroom of the Heard County Courthouse. In attendance at the meeting were Commission Chair June Jackson, District 1 Commissioner Karen Isenhower, District 2 Commissioner Jacob Cammon, District 3 Commissioner Gwen Caldwell, District 4 Commissioner Frank Crook, District 5 Commissioner Sandi Allen, and County Attorney Jerry Ann Conner. Commission Chair Jackson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone present. Mr. Randy Chesnut gave the invocation.

Agenda Item # 3 – Public Hearing – a. Application for Special Use for a

Telecommunications Tower – Range Towers II, LLC, Location Address – Property

owned by Dianna Hunter Knight, 2572 Glenn Road, Franklin, GA 30217
Commission Chair Jackson opened the public hearing and read the request made by

Range Towers II, LLC to erect a 180 ft. monopole communication tower on 56 acres of
agriculture zoned property owned by Dianne Hunter Knight, located on Glenn Road. She
stated that the Heard County Planning Commission did recommend approval of this
request. Mr. Matt Allen with Range Towers explained to the Board that all the standards
for review for a special use were met for this tower including the setbacks. He stated that
Range Towers is only asking for a 100 x 100 area to be rezoned, not the entire 56 acres.

There being no further comments from the Board or the public, on motion (Allen) and
second (Isenhower), the Board unanimously voted to close the public hearing.
